



HOW TO PREPARE YOUR BOAT FOR SAFE TRANSPORTATION

- Pack and secure any personal and other loose items and store them in a locked area. Valuable electronics should be removed and secured inside the boat.
- Remove plastic or Plexiglas fly bridge windshields, life jackets and seat cushions and store them the cabin. Do the same for cloth or canvas covers, tops and side curtains. Do not leave any boat covers on. The wind will most likely shred them during transportation. We will not be responsible for any damages caused by boat coverings.
- All cabinet/ locker doors and drawers inside the boat should be secured shut.
- Close any windows and hatches and make sure they are secured and sealed
- After everything is stored and secured inside the boat, lock the cabin and keep the key
- Drain all fuel and water tanks, disconnect batteries and tape cables
- Raise, lock and secure any inboard/outboard motors and outdrives
- If you ship your boat with a trailer/cradle you have to ensure you are using proper lashing material. The boat must be secured to the trailer/cradle with 2 straps in the front and 2 straps in the rear.
- If the boat does not have a trailer we can only pick up at a marina or boat yard. It is the owner's responsibility to make arrangements with the marina/boat yard to load the boat onto our trailer and pay for these services. The height of the boat cannot exceed 11' 6" for bridge clearance purposes. Any arches or fly bridges would have to be removed.
